Tri-Met Bus #15 stops at our front door, at 90th & Stark.

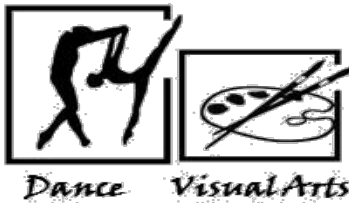
