Dance

Pre-Dance

An independent dance and movement experience that helps children develop into confident movers. Kids love to get moving to music that works on motor co-ordination, rhythm, and strength.

Ballet

Ballet technique is the foundation for all dance forms and excellent preparation other physical activities. Classical Ballet is offered in a progressive program, from Ballet 1 for those with little or no previous experience, through Advanced/Pre-professional.

Hip Hop Dance

As part of the urban culture of rap music, Hip Hop dance embraces several dance styles. Hip Hop dance has become part of our popular culture and continues to evolve.

Jazz Dance

Move and groove to today's music with age-appropriate dance steps. Jazz helps students gain co-ordination skills, flexibility and self-confidence, becoming poised and self-assured dancers.

Modern Dance

What began at the turn of the last century as a statement of rebellion, modern dance became the most significant influence in all theatrical dance forms. Based on the essence of pure movement, modern will inspire a new awareness for all dancers

Tap

Tap dance technique is an excellent way to develop a sense of rhythm and body coordination. The fundamentals of tap are taught in a progressive program of classes, with Level I being for students with little or no previous training.

Technical Theatre

Recreate a classic radio show complete with sound effects. Re-live the golden days of radio by working with original scripts from actual shows. Performances are held at our own theatre and throughout the community.
