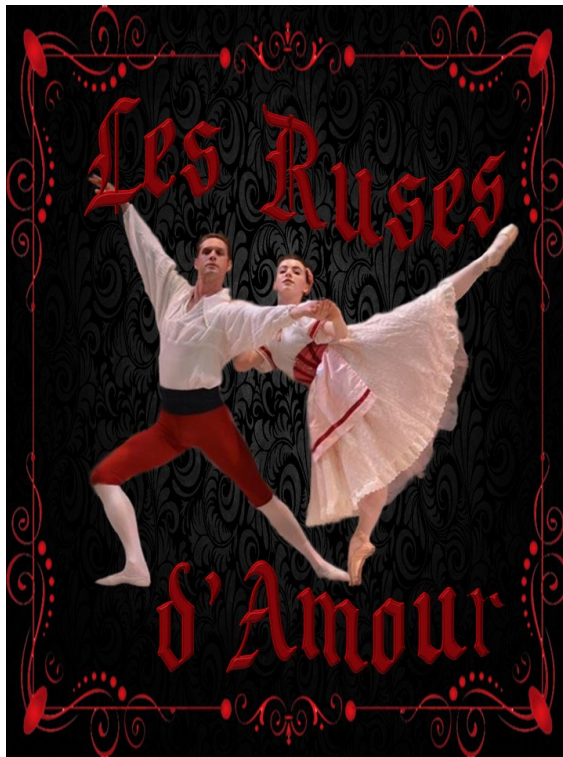


Don't Miss These Wonderful Events!

Join Us For A Summer Full of FUN!



This summer, have your child experience the arts by enrolling in Portland Metro Arts' summer camps! Camps are one of the best opportunities for children to explore their

creativity and artistic passion, in depth, that school year schedules may not allow.

PMA is unique because we offer camps focusing on dance, music, theatre, visual arts or a combination with multi-arts; unlike other programs dedicated to a single discipline with few options. We offer several week-long, all day, camps for children in grades 1-6. Camps run from 9:00am-4:00pm, Monday-Friday many camps involve a field trip or special event.

Half Day Option: If your child is unable to join us for a full-day camp, some of our camps have half-day am or pm options.

Childcare for Full-Day campers is available starting as early as 8:00am and going as late as 6:00pm, at no additional charge. Half-day AM campers may make use of before camp childcare and half-day PM campers may make arrangements to remain after camp until 6:00pm.

We also have camps for Preschool, Middle School and High School aged students.

Don't Forget Summer Dance Classes and Private Music Lessons

Learning an art form is a lifelong process of growth, development, and improvement. Many of the arts require skills and training - both physical and mental - that can deteriorate if too much time is spent without practice. To make sure students can continue to engage and improve in the arts we offer several dance class and private music lesson options during our summer season.

The Summer Dance Term consists of two, 4-week sessions: Session A, which will take place from **Monday 6/17 through Friday 7/10**; and Session B, which will take place from **Monday 7/15 through Friday 8/16**. Families may enroll in each session separately, or for the entire term at a discounted rate.

Summer is also a great time to try something new. Begin to learn a new instrument or try a different type of dance for a month. If you like it, sign up for the next session!

Summer private music lessons are being offered for 8 weeks from **Monday 6/17 through Friday 8/16**. Students can opt to take 2 to 8 weeks of lessons.
